


VOM74MM Troubleshooting



Seeing "No Signal" on Display	Monitor Always On or Functions are INOP	
 The monitor will display "No Signal" when one of the following is true. The monitor is on a CH SOURCE that does not have a camera connected. The camera is not connected. The camera has failed. 	 The monitor will lock up and only display a single CH SOURCE when a CAMERA TRIGGER sees voltage. The monitor's POWER, MENU, and SELECT buttons will do nothing while a CH SOURCE is triggered. If a CAMERA TRIGGER is active please check the BLUE, BROWN, and GREEN wires for voltage. A CAMERA TRIGGER does not need to be connected.
